

## Food Waste Energy Plant Opened

**T**he first food waste to energy plant in Australia, at Camellia in western Sydney, was opened on February 25th by NSW Energy Minister, Kim Yeadon.

The \$36 MM facility has a full generation capacity of 3.5 MW, which can power about 3,000 homes, and has been pre-sold to NSW regional energy supplier Country Energy

under a three-year deal. Yeadon said the facility is expected to realise significant long-term environmental and economic benefits for regional and metropolitan energy suppliers and the broader community.

It is owned by Earthpower Technologies Sydney, a 91% owned subsidiary of Environmental Infrastructure Limited.
