Current geological education program at Aso Geopark, Japan

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Curators at Aso Volcano Museum, one of the base facilities of Aso Geopark, have developed a unique variety of geological education programs

for elementary to high school students in the area of Aso Geopark. The museum staff supports school educational activities through lectures

and field trips, using unique geological and topographic features around the school, as well as natural bounty and disasters. Teachers and

students work closely to develop an educational curriculum that encourages students' interests, and stimulate their ideas on regional resources

and their preservation. At the end of this educational program, students organize a symposium to present and share their work with students

from different schools.

These programs increase students' attachment to the regional resources, and provide a chance to learn and discover Aso's precious nature

through sharing ideas with oth- er students. At the same time, the student's messages also deliver huge impact to adult's ideas concerning their

local communities.

Apart from these museum educational activities, learning about grasslands is also delivered through Aso Geopark activities. A variety of

subjects related to the regional geological resources tend to widen to this educational program.
