

Jurassic wells are drilled on north-south 80 acre units. Cumulative production from the Cotton Valley sands amounted to 1,231,049 barrels to August 1, 1951. The "A" and "B" zones had produced a total of 5,757,921 barrels of oil and distillate to August 1, 1951, the bulk of which was from the "B" zone. The "A" zone had produced about 7-1/2 million MCF gas, as compared to almost 60 million MCF for the "B" zone.^M

The paper is intended as a summary of facts and ideas contributed by a number of geologists. Most of the information has been published previously, and interpretation is subject to revision.
