

Eastern Star Gas Aims To Cash In On CSG in NSW

Eastern Star Gas (ESG) has highlighted its place within Australia's rising coal seam gas (CSG) production industry, with aims to be a major supplier of CSG to the New South Wales market.

In a presentation at the recent Good Oil Conference, David Casey, ESG executive

director of operation announced the company's estimated 2P (proven plus probable) gas reserves target of 600 Bcf in 2009.

Casey said that the company's primary focus is on exploration, appraisal and development of the CSG resources within PEL 238, a 9,100 km² license area in the Gunnedah Basin

which contains a gas resource in excess of 17 Tcf.

Casey explained to the conference that ESG is aiming to demonstrate the commercial potential and establish gas reserves at its Biblewindi-9 pilot well, with all its wells being automated. ■
