

## Arrow Scores Bullseye With Fifth CSG Project

**A**row Energy has the green light to develop its fifth coal seam gas (CSG) project in Australia after the Queensland Government awarded permit PL 252, covering 76 km<sup>2</sup> in Stratheden in the Surat Basin approximately 20 km northwest of Dalby.

The Stratheden project will be Arrow's fourth CSG field development in the Surat Basin,

adding to the company's Tipton West, Kogan North and Daandine projects. The company's gas production project portfolio also includes the Moranbah gas project in the Bowen Basin.

Arrow Managing Director Nick Davies said Stratheden would be developed in conjunction with an expansion to the company's Daandine project to supply gas to the soon to be commissioned Braemer 2 power station.

The Braemer 2 power station is a joint venture between Arrow and ERM Power. Arrow will supply 11.5 PJ/a of gas to the 450 MW power station. Braemer 2 is scheduled to be fully operational by the middle of 2009 and will take Arrow's net integrated electricity generation capacity to 370 MW. ■
