

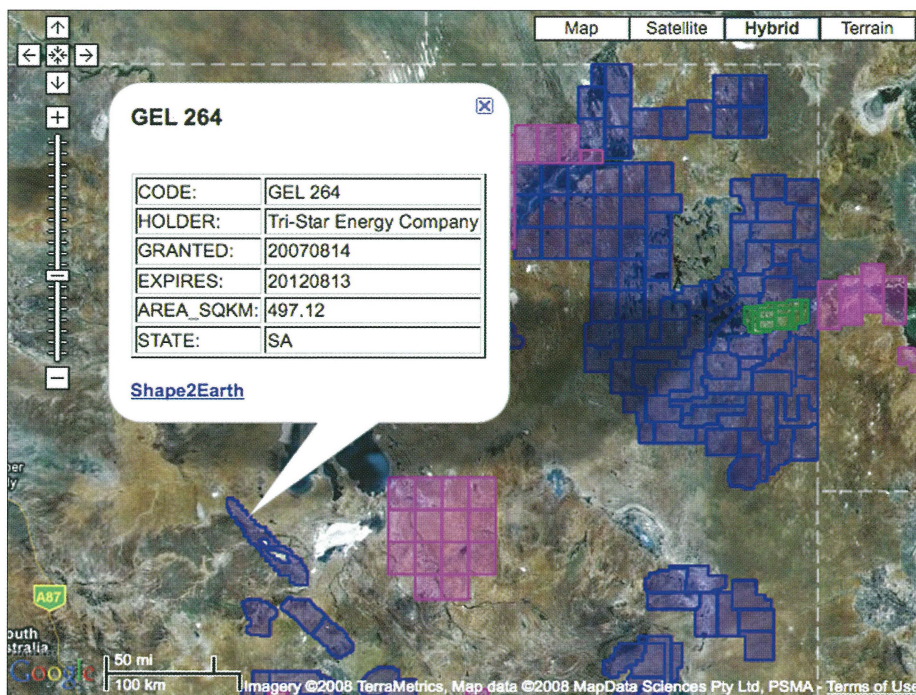
New Interactive Geothermal Tenement Map

Ever wondered who is doing what, and where, on the Australian geothermal scene?

Until now, the only way to access geothermal tenement information in Australia was to scour through the on-line GIS databases maintained by each state and territory authority, with each authority using different software and each producing its own file outputs. Hot Dry Rocks Pty Ltd (HDRPL) has compiled all state and territory geothermal tenements, and these can now be viewed and interrogated (free of charge) on a single, simple website. Although not a new idea to the petroleum sector, this is a new application to the growing geothermal industry in Australia.

The HDRPL Interactive Tenement Map utilises GoogleMaps as the mapping platform. The viewer can zoom-in and see the tenements in map, terrain or satellite view. Tenement metadata have been standardised and key information (ownership, size, dates etc) can be viewed with a click of the mouse.

It is hoped that the new interactive tenement map will become a repository of geothermal information on a tenement-by-tenement basis and will be a



portal for those seeking information on Australian geothermal exploration and development.
